How new members' handicaps will be calculated

- Initial placing into flight will come from application info regarding members scoring average or handicap
- If member is not eligible for prize money (has not established two round history) their first and last name will show up in all Capital Letters. The last name will continue to show in all Capital letters until after six rounds have been posted.
- Handicaps for new members will be calculated manually for the third through six tournaments posted for that member using the following methodology. After the first six rounds posted for that member handicaps will be calculated using the USGA handicap system.
 - After playing two rounds the difference in score and par (differential) for courses played is averaged. That difference will be handicap for third outing.
 - After three rounds the average of the differential for the two lowest rounds will result in handicap for fourth round.
 - After four rounds the average of the differential for three lowest rounds will result in the handicap for the fifth round
 - After five rounds the average of the differential for three lowest rounds will result in the handicap for the sixth round
