2017 TTSGA Board of Directors Meeting #2

Subject: Minutes of TTSGA Meeting June 5, 2017

The meeting was opened at 7:30 A. M. by President Allan Bleich at the Hendersonville Cracker Barrel. Members present were: Warren Pettit, Bill Taylor, Charlie Morris, Art Alexander, Bud Woodby, Burl Young and Bob McDaniel. Member absent: Jerry Ashley.

Treasurer's Report: Bob reported that we currently have [REDACTED] in the bank with all bills paid.

Tournaments: Much discussion was made about courses requiring us to have a minimum number of players or we pay a penalty. The courses that require contracts have clauses that highly favor them and the penalties can be a heavy financial burden to the association. **Motion** was made by Burl and 2nd by Art that we do not enter into any future contracts. Voted on and passed unanimously. Burl reviewed new member handicaps and unfortunately Jack Knies did not qualify for membership as his handicap is above the 36 maximum allowed. Bob will contact Jack and refund monies due him. We have no one on the waiting list to take Jack's place. **Motion** was made by Burl and 2nd by Bill that all future cancellations for play in a tournament must be made at least by noon on the Friday prior to the upcoming tournament. Voted on and passed unanimously.

Rules: Clarification of rule #13 for dropping the ball over a water hazard. Allan drew up a chart for members to review the interpretation of the rule. **The rule does not change as it is currently written.** Burl is to e-mail out the chart to all members with his announcement of our next tournament at Montgomery Bell. Rule #7 was discussed and it will remain as written with no changes.

Slow Pay: More emphasis will be made to finish our tournaments in no more than 5 hours. Members will be encouraged to spend no more than 3 minutes looking for a ball as our rule requires, players should continue playing their ball while the player with a lost ball looks for his and they can help him if time allows. Bob Hill will be contacted by Bill to see if he would volunteer to marshal play while he is recuperating. Per rule #14 a group that has a full hole open in front of them, each player may be assessed a two shot penalty. Ready play can help players catch up as we do not want faster players penalized because of their slower partners. **Motion** by Burl 2nd by Bill that if we have a designated marshal (Bob Hill) that he should stay with the group that is behind to make sure that they are spending no more than 15 minutes to play a hole and they stay on time. Voted on and passed unanimously.

Luncheons: The shortage of food at Legacy was addressed and Warren recommended that if we serve barbecue, it should be placed on a bun in the player's plate and that would constitute a full serving. The cookie monster will be authorized to take care of future luncheons without needing approval.

Annual Meeting: Per Bud Bob will send out a reminder of the annual meeting when he sends out the tournament results.

Review of Action Items: Allan and Bob reviewed the motions and pertinent items for inclusion in the minutes. They were in agreement.

Attachment: Water Hazard Interpretation

Assumptions:

1. You have to try to cross the Water Hazard. If you go into Water Hazard, then the Table applies
2. Yellow staked" implies "water hazard".
3. Lateral hazards are "red staked" and can be played 2 club lengths from the point where the ball "last" crossed the margin of the hazard.
