

MINUTES OF TTSGA ANNUAL MEETING AT BLUEGRASS COUNTRY CLUB

NOVEMBER 9, 2017

The dinner portion of the meeting was called to order at 6:00 P. M. by President Allan Bleich. Reservations were made for 104 members and 66 guests. We had one no show. Art Alexander gave the opening prayer.

The business meeting began at 7 P M and Allan asked all military veterans to stand and be recognized. The membership was then asked to stand and say the pledge of allegiance (100% did). The current board was asked to stand and be recognized: 1st V P Warren Pettit, 2nd V P Bill Taylor; Sec/Tr Bob McDaniel; Tournament Director Burl Young; Social Director Bud Woodby; Rules Committee Jerry Ashley, chm, Charlie Morris; Past President Art Alexander. Financial Report: Bob reported that we carried \$5,362 over from 2016, had income of \$24210 and expenses of \$23, 792 leaving a net surplus of \$5,780 with liabilities of \$80 for application fees and Hole in One pot of \$740. Since no one scored a hole in one this year, the pot rolls over to next year with no fees from current members. We are currently keeping more money in cash due to deposits required by our courses and Bluegrass for our meeting. We expect to carryover \$4600 to 2018.

Social Chairman Report: Bud asked if everyone was pleased with having our annual meeting at Bluegrass and got a very positive response. He reported that we were able to get 53 free rounds of golf and 7 grand prizes from the courses that we play for door prizes. Every member received comparable prizes and our guests received a box of Russell Stover candy. Bud works throughout the year in gathering prizes, planning the dinner and organizing the entire evening. We owe him a lot of thanks.

Handicap/Tournament Report: Burl reported that he is working on next year's courses and it looks like this year's schedule was popular and will probably be repeated. He announced the
